Consistency: This is year marks Rock Springs' 70th year delivering quality programs to youth, the 110th anniversary of 4-H programming in the state of Kansas, and 114th anniversary of 4-H's founding. We have been delivering quality experiences to youth longer than anyone else.

Investment: Over the last few years, thousands of donors who understand and support the mission of the Kansas 4-H Foundation and the great work done at Rock Springs have given millions of dollars to fund capital improvements and program enhancements at Rock Springs.





Experience: You would be hard pressed to find a more experienced and committed staff, anywhere in the state at facilities similar to ours, than what we have at Rock Springs. A few examples include:

 very familiar with 4-H programming having served as a club leader for two years.
- There is also a handful of staff at Rock Springs that has been a part of the great work that we do for almost 30 years each.

Leadership: The Kansas 4-H Foundation which is the owner/operator of Rock Springs is the largest state 4-H foundation in the country, and has an incredible and influential board of trustees whose backgrounds are as diverse as the parts of the state they represent.

Uniqueness of Resources: We have elements and capacity at Rock Springs that you will not find at other facilities in the state comparable to us such as one of the largest natural springs in Kansas, housing capacity of almost 900 guests at one time, or a newly remodeled Heritage Hall which includes Spencer Auditorium capable of seating just under 400 people.
