

YOUTH FOR THE QUALITY CARE OF ANIMALS (YQCA)

You **MUST** first be enrolled in 4Honline for the year to log onto the YQCA course at yqca.learngrow.io

You will use your **FAMILY** 4Honline login and password information (login and password your family uses to enroll in 4-H) to access the courses for the **ACTIVE** youth in your family. Only **ACTIVE** members will show in the drop down menu for access to the course.

All registration questions with YQCA should be directed to help@yqca.org. There will not be local support for the YQCA program.

All 4-Hers need to use the 4-H tab and not the FFA tab even if they are members of both organizations. Youth members of FFA **ONLY** need to use the FFA tab.

There is a button for families that have forgotten their 4Honline password. We do not have access to your passwords.

The YQCA site is user friendly and should make it easy for 4-H families to complete their QA training for this year. **DO NOT WAIT UNTIL THE DEADLINE NEARS AS THE COURSE DOES TAKE SOME TIME TO WORK THROUGH AND COMPLETE THE NECESSARY INFORMATION AND QUIZZES.**

Youth can register for an online course they complete as their time allows or they can enroll in a 1-hour Face to Face “Instructor Led” class. **YOU MUST PRE-REGISTER FOR EITHER OPTION AND PAY THE ONLINE FEES USING A CREDIT CARD.**

4-H and FFA youth exhibiting at the County Fair, State Fair or Ak-Sar-Ben must complete the YQCA training in order to exhibit beef, goats, sheep, swine, poultry or rabbits. Failure to complete this require will make you ineligible to exhibiting your animals.

YQCA MODULES MUST BE COMPLETED USING THE YQCA SITE AND 1 PRINTED CERTIFICATE ON FILE AT THE EXTENSION OFFICE BY JUNE 15 OF EACH YEAR. NO EXCEPTIONS!

It is your responsibility to complete this requirement by the deadline if you want to exhibit your livestock projects.
